Noah Bellamy has spent the last ten years as an in demand performer, arranger, and educator. He has arranged music that has been performed by artists such as Wynton Marsalis and The Lincoln Center Jazz Orchestra, Grammy Award Winner Bob Belden, Grammy Award Nominee Fred Hersch, and Grammy Award Nominee Conrad Herwig. In 2004, The New York All-State Honor Jazz Ensemble performed his arrangement of 'Rapture' with guest artist Conrad Herwig.

From 1996-2006 Noah was a staff member for the Centerville High School marching band, serving as the visual caption head from 2001 to 2006. It was during this time at Centerville that he and Tim Fairbanks started the Centerville High School Winter Drumline, winner of WGI PSO class in 1999 and WGI PSW class in 2004. In 2006 Mr. Bellamy was a member of the visual and design team for Rhythm X and served as the director for the WGI Finalist Centerville 'A' Drumline.

Noah is currently the program coordinator for the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Eagle Regiment as well as the visual designer for the Stoneman Douglas Winter Percussion Ensemble. Noah holds educator endorsements with Dynasty Band USA, Innovative Percussion, and Remo and continues to be a nationally in-demand clinician, consultant and designer.
